

Skate Celje Safety Measures and Covid19 restrictions

Due to the COVID-19 pandemic situation and public health issues the Organizers can only host the competition in accordance with the effective medical and government regulations as followed:

Before entering the ice rink

Verification of compliance to the **VRT (vaccinated/recovered/tested)** rule is going to be performed at the points of entry.

After verifying the VRT rule, every event attendee (e.g. Event Officials, Judges, Team Members) will be tested **RAGT** (rapid antigen test) free of charge. Only upon a negative RAGT result the entering to the ice rink and registration office will be allowed. Every 48 hours RAGT will be repeated at the entrance.

Body temperature will be measured with non-contact thermometers at the entrance as well.

Questionnaire for the assessment of medical conditions needs to be fulfilled by every person who wishes to enter the ice rink.

During the event

All event attendees are kindly asked not to come to the ice rink more than 75 minutes before their warming group. For your own safety we also recommend that you make your stay at the ice rink as short as possible.

Obligation to use a protective mask:

Indoors: the use of a protective mask is mandatory when moving and staying in all enclosed public places or spaces except during the training and competing.

In open public places: the use of a protective mask is not mandatory unless it is not possible to provide a person-to-person distance of at least 1.5 meters.

While practicing sports (on ice or off ice) protective mask is not compulsory for athletes, but it is for coaches and other team members.

Only protective surgical mask or mask type FFP2 is recognised and approved for use as a protective mask; fabric masks are no longer approved for use.

Hand disinfection:

Upon entering an enclosed space, hand disinfection with a disinfectant registered for this purpose is mandatory.

Keeping distance:

Participants must keep a distance of at least 1.5 meters from each other.

Please note that no public is allowed throughout the event (for the practice and for the competition) and that there is no public access to the ice rink.

Awarding ceremony

Awarding ceremony will take place ice off the followed immediately after each category. Only the first three competitors will be invited on the ceremony.

Upon departure

The Organizer will provide RAGT as well as PCR testing for those who might need such a test in order to return to their countries or to travel. Please, sign for the test at the registration office when checking in. Payment for the tests is required.
